It's tournament time again! Of course we have several coming up in the next few months. Check out the Baronial calendar for the most up to date and recent information on all of the tournaments of Western Seas.

First up in the calendar and coming fast on July 21 is the Castlenorth Grand Prize Tourney. In this heavy combat tournament, participants enter the lysts by submitting a prize. All of the prizes are placed upon a table for all to see. At the end of the tourney, the person with the highest accrued points gets to pick from the prize table. Then the next person, then the next, as determined by points earned. There may be other contests for those not fighting — which will be announced on the day of the event. This event is being held at Windward Community College, on the green. Please bring your own shade and refreshments as it is expected to be sunny and hot.

Next on the calendar on August 25, the Canton of Valley Azure is hosting the Spear of Destiny Tournament. Being held at the 4th Marine Division Memorial Park in Haiku on Maui. This tournament is a round robin of heavy fighting until a victor is left standing. Registration is free and is sure to draw a crowd.



Becoming Baron & Baroness

The Crown of the Kingdom Caid, as in all SCA Kingdoms, is responsible for selecting a Baron and Baroness for each of its baronial territories, including the Barony of Western Seas. At its establishment as a Barony, the Barony of Western Seas asked that the Barony be able to select its Baron and Baroness through a competitive process. That request was approved in Kingdom Law and because the barony was unique in the process by which the Baron and Baroness would be selected, the barony was referenced as a palatine barony in Kingdom Law. Note that this does not remove the responsibility the Crown has for finding a suitable Baron and Baroness for the Barony and hence the need for contestants to submit Letters of Intent to satisfy the resume requirement in kingdom law. Further, all Barons and Baronesses must abide by the Barony of Western Seas Traditions.

Hear ye all hopeful Barons and Baronesses! As representatives of the crown for this Palatine Barony, Baron Valeran and Baroness Sadhbh wish to announce the next Baronial Tournement to be held in the fall. Gooking with Glaudio

Hi boys and girls,

This time we will do a recipe from my new book from the Slalom family (a father and two daughters). There are three books: *Scheherazade's Feasts*, *The Sweets of Araby*, and my favorite, *Sweet Delights*. The books are not only cookbooks, but a historical study on cooking. In all of these books, you will find history on Arab cooking and insights on food and the dishes are made to let you know how they came out. For example, in *Sweet Delights* it shows you the original medieval recipe as Historical Version, than it has a adaptation called Traditional Recipe, and finely modern variation called Modern Recipe. And may I suggest *Medieval Arab Cookery* by Maxime Rodinson, A.J. Arberry and Charles Perry, it's a rewright of an old book, *A Bagdad Cookery Book*, the book has been done in a new format and it gives you better info with essays and in-depth knowledge of the recipes.

We will be doing a cookie today. It's a stuffed, dry cookie with sugar and almonds (AL-Ka'k Al-Mahshu). The reason I picked this recipe is that in my family we made almost the same cookie in Italy for over five generations. I came from a small town in Abruzzi in the province of Chiet in a small town called Casalbordino. To this day, you will find my mom's last name, Colantonio, in the books. Her name is as old as the town. From a Roman settlement to an 11th century town on the side of the Adriatic Sea. And our town got it's mane from Roberto Bordimus, a feudal lord. At one time there was some influence from the Arabs. One thing about food is that when a group leaves, the food stays. In our family version of the recipe we use oil, flour, and white wine for the dough, then we make a filling of nuts, raisins, and spices cooked in wine; then we stuff the dough, shape it in a crescent moon, and bake it. In the Arab recipe you got a yeast dough with sugar and almond and spices as it's filling and it's baked and we both call them cookies.

There is one more book I would like to suggest and that is *La Cucina* containing over 2000 authentic recipes of Italian cooking. It isn't a period book, but is about real Italian cooking off all over Italy. For me, it's a good reference book, our family recipe is a combination of two recipes, Christmas Spice Cookies and Jam-Filled Horseshoe Cookies that are in the book and only made in

Abruzzi. But on with this cookie now.

Ingredients

2 cups flour

1/4 up olive oil

1/4 cup warm water

1/8 cup rose water

1 pack yeast

1/2 tsp. salt

1/2 cup slivered Almonds

1/2 cup sugar

1/4 tsp ground ginger

1/4 tsp. ground cinnamon

1/8 tsp.cloves

1/8 tsp.ground pepper

1/8 tsp. spikenard


1/8/tsp. camphor

powdered sugar for dusting



Notes: Spikenard has a taste between Licorice and Sarsaprilla, it's optional or you could use ground licorice and a little root beer extract. Camphor is really strong and it smells like vicks and if you ask me it has the same tastes if you are go to use it a little goes a long way or you could use mental extract.

1. Get all your Ingredients ready, as in **pic one**. Top row from left to right: flour, olive oil, rose water, almonds, powdered sugar; middle row: yeast, salt, sugar, ginger; bottom row: cloves, cinnamon, spikenard, camphor, black pepper.



- 2. Add flour, 1 tsp sugar, yeast, and warm water and let yeast bloom 5 min
- 3. Take oil, bloomed yeast and add to flour and make a dough then let rise for 1 hour as in **pic two**
- 4. Take almonds and sugar and grind together as in **pic three**, then add the rest of ingredients as in **pic four**, then add rose water and make a filling to look like **pic five**.
- 5. Now take some dough and make 1 1/2 inch. balls, then roll them out and put filling at the top then fold over the filling and roll it and pinch the ends and shape like a horse shoe as in **pic six** (you will have to roll the dough because it's a bread dough if you just pinch it close it will open when you bake it.)



6. Bake at 350 for 20 min take them out and dust with powder sugar.

Several release forms and waivers are necessary for various activities by the Barony, Kingdom, and Society. Printable versions of these can be found at <u>WesternSeas.org</u>.

SCA Model Release Form

Required to be signed by subject when...

- the image is portrait-style.
- the photo is taken in a private space t an event (such as personal encampment).
- the photograph is taken at a non-public venue (sch as an armor-making workshop at a home or closed event).

SCA Photograph Grant of Use Form

Required to be signed b te photographer of any and all photos in use after December 31, 2010.

A photographer may check the "Perpetual Grants of Use" box, meaning the form is required only one time and it covers any photograph submitted for use by the Barony now or in the future.

SCA Creative Work Copyright Assignment / Grant of Use Form

Required to be signed by the author or rtist for the following...

- articles, poems, stories songs written content submitted for publication.
- original artwork (not clip art) submitted digitally for publication.

No form is needed for...

- correspondence from officers or event organizers.
- Event notices.
- Captions to photographs.

Caid Personal Information Release

Required to be signed when...


- Event organizers wish to use their personal email / phone number as contact in public display.
- Officers wish to have their modern names used in the Regnum.
- Articles writerswish to use their moden name in the by-line.

Waivers are to be submitted with pertinent works to the Chronicler and/or the Webwright. Waivers can be submitted digitally (scanned as PDF or JPG). Hard-copies received will be scanned. All waivers are stored digitally in a private filing system managed by Kingdom Cid. Hard-copy Waivers are kept on file with the Constable after being scanned.

Combat and Equestrian Waivers special waivers needed to participte in events related to eash. Please speak to the Field Marshal of the event for more information.

Blue Card vs. White Card

SCA members who have (digitally) signed a Waiver of Liability when paying for membership possess a Blue Membership Card. Members who have not (digitally) signed this waiver have a White Membership Card. If a member possesses a White Card, that member must sign Combat Waivers at each relaed event to participte in combat. See the Field Marshal of the event if there are any questions.
